Office Managed

- Severe aggressive physical contact
- Bullying
- Fighting
- Property Destruction
- Vandalism
- Weapons
- Patterns of Aggressive Behavior
- Foul/Profane Language
- Credible Threats
- Harassment of Student or Adults
- Sexual Harassment
- Indecent Exposure of Private Body Parts
- Major/Chronic Refusal to Follow School Rules
- Major Dishonesty
- Theft
- Racial/Ethnic Discrimination
- Plagiarism
- Hazing
- Dress Code Violations
